As a private computer support consultant, he assisted exploration companies and geologists, the most noteworthy of which was a CIDA project to Jamaica regarding a metalliferous survey of the island. In 1996, Spencer began work as the market research analyst for a newly invigorated CAMESE – the Canadian Association of Mining Equipment and Services for Export.
