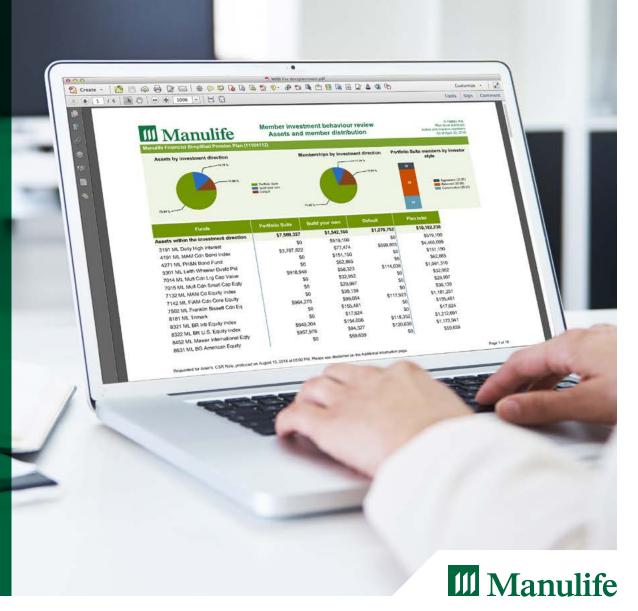

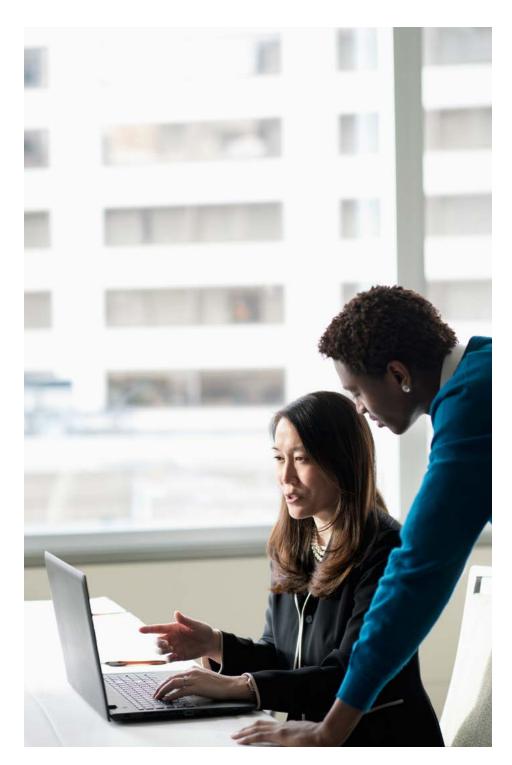

What it shows

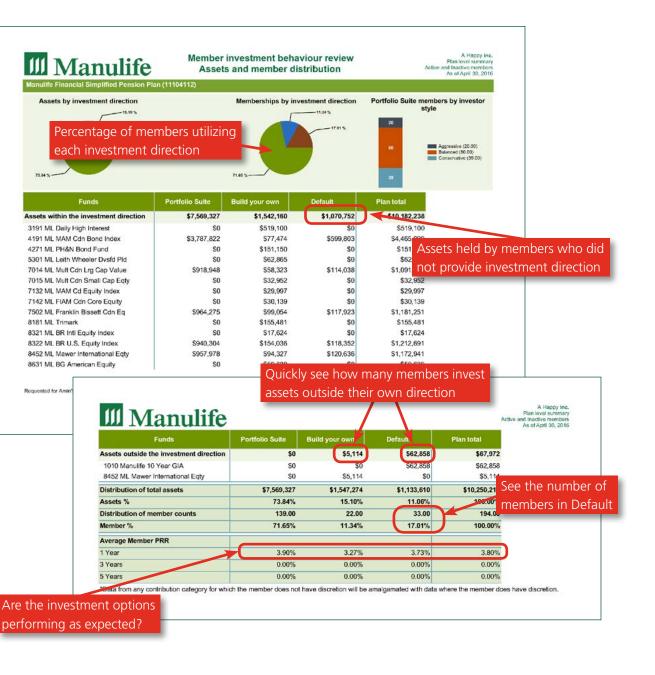
This section shows you member and asset distribution by investment option, both within and outside investment direction.

What it shows

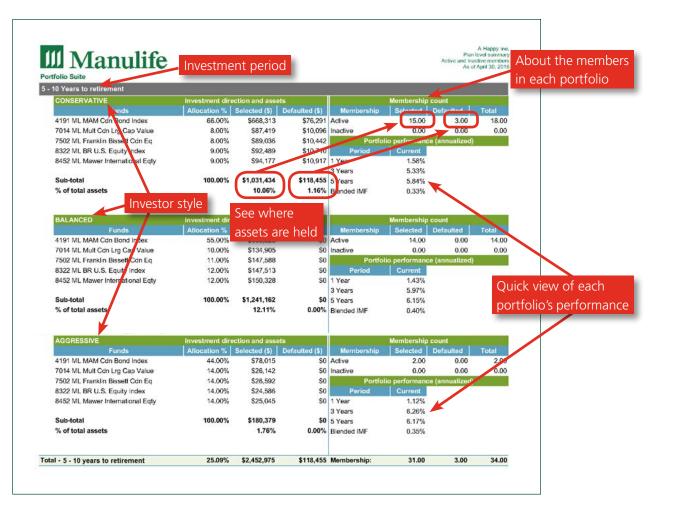
This section gives details on each portfolio, including distribution of assets, membership counts and performance.

What it tells you

You can also see how each portfolio is performing according to investor style and investment period.
